**FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT
SEWER DEPARTMENT INFORMATION**

Donnie Schmitt was present to discuss the sewer stoppage at his residence 503 N. Second, this caused sewer to back up into his basement. Town guys went and checked on situation and determined it was not Town related. Donnie then call Lewis's, they snaked out the line and didn't find any blockage on his line. Clyde made a motion and Bernard seconded to pay the bill from Lewis's in the amount of \$253.00.

WATER DEPARTMENT INFORMATION

Dean stated that it would cost approximately \$700.00 to put it field tile out at the wells. This would take care of the water situation at the wells. Currently there is not any place for water to drain. Council approved this price for the tile and also gave permission to Dennis Simpson to tie into the tile to help drain water from his field which surrounds our wells.

STREET DEPARTMENT INFORMATION

Dean Short has pictures of damages caused by semi's running up into property on the corner of First Street & Rock Road. Dennis Simpson was present to ask if town would possibly widen Rock Road in order for semi's to make the turn. Council disagreed to act on this request at this time. The county has moved some signs from the corner and the city has moved a sign to help with the problem Jack Light asked about Handicap parking in front of the Dayspring Church. Dale suggested that the Church should draw up details on the parking and give to Mr. Druley to get an ordinance for it.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Rodger requested that the parking in front of the Town Hall limited to 30 minutes. Ray Druley will draft an ordinance for this.

CLERK TREASURER'S REPORT**

The Deputy Clerk submitted the March water/sewer information to the Council as well as a February Fund Report. May 8th has been scheduled as Clean up Day.
