# Ordinance 2018-16

---

## **An Ordinance Designating a No-Parking Zone on both sides of Rock Road**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Owensville (hereinafter “Town”, “Owensville”, or “Town of Owensville” with said terms used interchangeably) desires to regulate parking on both sides of Rock Road.

**WHEREAS**, Indiana Code 36-1-3, which is commonly known as the “home rule”, provides that local governments (such as cities and towns) have the authority to do anything not specifically prohibited by federal or state rules and regulations.

**WHEREAS**, this legislation was passed at a meeting conducted by the Town Council; said meeting was in compliance with the public meeting law, which is codified at Indiana Code 5-14-1.5.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Indiana Code 36-5-2-9.2, the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was attended by a majority of all of the elected Town Council members of the legislative body.

**WHEREAS**, said legislation was introduced and discussed at a regular Town Council meeting on November 5, 2018. It was then passed through the mechanism provided by Indiana Code 36-5-2-9.8 (including suspension of the rules) at the December 4, 2018 meeting.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OWENSVILLE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:**

The entire length of Rock Road is hereby designated, effective immediately, a no-parking zone.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Council of the Town of Owensville Indiana, this 4th day of December 2018. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage.
